

"After I Register" Checklist

After you have registered for your first semester of courses at NTCC, please follow these steps.

□ **1. Review the 7-Steps to Success Checklist. Have you completed all of the steps?** <u>All information can be found in your myEagle portal.</u>

2. Follow up with Financial Aid & the Business Office.

PELL Award status and payment balances can be checked in the "Financial" tab of your myEagle portal.

3. Get your Parking Sticker & Student ID at the Student Services Center.

Complete the Parking Sticker Registration Form in your myEagle portal prior to arriving on campus. Select STUDENT, STUDENT LIFE and then PARKING. When you come to pick up your parking sticker, please bring your Driver's License with you and get your Student ID made.

4. Visit the NTCC Bookstore to get your books, supplies, and other NTCC

merchandise. *Please note that charges can<u>not</u> be made to your financial aid account until 2-weeks before class starts.*

5. Prepare your computer for Blackboard, and download your NTCC email to your phone.

□ 8. Register early.

Register for courses early so that you can get the ideal schedule for you. Spring registration opens in November, and Summer and Fall registration will open in April.

9. Visit NTCC's Career and Transfer Center to explore your future options.
