

Northeast Texas Community College (NTCC) is seeking its next president. A progressive, rural college with approximately 3,000 students, NTCC is looking for a dynamic leader to build upon its 40-year legacy of excellence. This is a unique opportunity to lead a small college with a big vision.

NTCC is located centrally between Camp, Morris and Titus Counties in Northeast Texas (two hours east of Dallas) on a scenic 500+ acre campus. It offers a wide variety of workforce programs designed to meet the rapidly-evolving needs of the regional economy, ranging from micro-credential programs to associate degrees. NTCC also serves traditional university-bound students through a full core curriculum and has transfer agreements with numerous universities. Additionally, the college has a robust dual credit program and strong partnerships with local school districts.

NTCC boasts a highly active Phi Theta Kappa chapter and one of the top community college Honors programs in the country. The college completed a major renovation project in 2017, funded by a successful bond initiative passed in 2015. NTCC provides modern student housing for up to 250 residents and offers five varsity sports options. It is also home to unique instructional programs, including the Carroll Shelby Automotive Technology Program, named after the late auto racing legend who supported the program in his later years.

The president reports to the Board of Trustees and is responsible for providing visionary leadership across all academic and administrative areas to support the college's mission, vision, and strategic goals. The successful candidate will hold a doctoral degree and have at least five years in a senior executive role, preferably in a community college setting.
